### Session 5: Invite others into true life – Evangelism

Live an intentional and invitational life. Regularly invite others to walk with you as you follow Jesus. Intentionally build relationships with ALL of God's people. Practice "pre-conversion discipleship".

## INVITING TO LIFE

John 4: "If you knew the gift of God and who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water"

Simply put: The work of Jesus in the world is to offer living water to people drinking from a stagnant well. This was always the mark of Jesus' ministry, and it should be the same mark for ours. Jesus couldn't help himself; he "had to go through Samaria". He had to offer living water. Jesus was the first missionary, calling people to be in right relationship with the father, and offering life to a dying world. Does this mark your life as well? Jesus has placed you in communities and relationships on campus so that you can offer living water. If people only knew who it is that offer them water, they would drink. Who is going to tell them who it is? Your mission is just this; to proclaim the messiah to the campus, and offer the living water of the Gospel.

## PRACTICE YOUR STORY

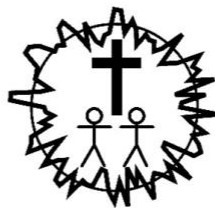
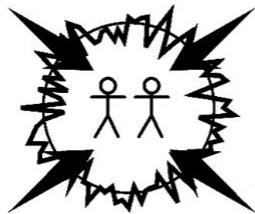
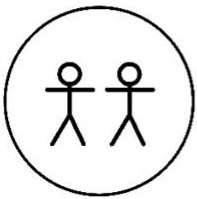
(Take 2 minutes each person)
